Travel Advisory Myanmar: Visa On Arrival

Effective from 30th August 2023 until 29th August 2024, Myanmar has allowed Visa on Arrival (VOA) for Tourists with regular passport holders of China and India visiting the country.

Visa on Arrival is only for tourist purposes and will provide only a tourist visa and Extensions of stay will not be permitted.

The VOA system is applicable to all International Airports, including Yangon International Airport, Mandalay International Airport, and Nay Pyi Taw International Airport.

A 50 USD fee for VOA will be collected by the respective Government Authorities, which will allow for a 30-day stay for tourism only.

Passengers are required to prepare the following documents before being accepted at check-in counters:

- 2 Passport size photos
- Confirm Return Ticket
- Confirm hotel booking
- Sufficient fund (Immigration officer will check)

Travel Advisory Myanmar: Update entry requirement

Covid-19 Vaccine certificate is no longer required.

Entry Requirement to Myanmar issued on (1-9-2023):

1. Travelers shall submit a Health Declaration Form to the respective health authorities upon arrival to Myanmar.
2. Foreigners shall submit a health insurance to the respective health authorities upon arrival to Myanmar (If they can submit the health insurance documents from the relevant country or internationally recognized insurance companies, they can exempt from purchasing COVID-19 health insurance from Myanmar insurance.

If they cannot present any relevant document, they shall purchase the COVID-19 medical insurance from Myanmar insurance. Detailed information can be obtained at the Myanmar Insurance's website (<https://www.mminsurance.gov.mm>).

Cambodia News

Qatar Airways to resume flights (Doha ~ Phnom Penh) on October 29

Qatar Airways will resume the Doha-Phnom Penh flights on October 29, connecting Cambodia to one of the busiest air traffic hubs of the world.

The airline used to fly daily between Doha and Phnom Penh but the Covid-19 pandemic put an end to it. Qatar Airways stopped the Phnom Penh flight in April 2020.

Currently, there are 31 airlines operating in Cambodia, as against 41 airlines operated before the pandemic in 2019.



Siem Reap's New Airport

The new Siem Reap Angkor International Airport is scheduled to open on 16 October 2023 and the new airport is located 40 km (25 mi) east of Angkor Wat and 50 km (31 mi) southeast of Siem Reap.

All flights to and from Siem Reap are scheduled to operate at the new airport as of 16 October 2023.

The new airport will have 38 gates and will be able to handle large passenger planes like the Airbus A-340-300 and A350-900 as well as the Boeing B777-200/300ER and B747-300/400.
